

LETTER OF AGREEMENT between ALASKA AIRLINES, INC. and the ASSOCIATION OF FLIGHT ATTENDANTS-CWA, AFL-CIO

EXCESSIVE TIME CLEARING CBP AT TBIT

12 This LETTER OF AGREEMENT is made between ALASKA AIRLINES, INC. ("Company") 13 and the Flight Attendants in the service of Alaska Airlines, Inc., as represented by the 14 ASSOCIATION OF FLIGHT ATTENDANTS-CWA, AFL-CIO ("Association"). 15

16 WHEREAS, the Company and the Association (collectively "the parties") recognize the 17 excessive amount of time required to transit Customs and Border Protection (CBP) 18 checkpoints at Tom Bradley International Terminal (TBIT) (Los Angeles International 19 Airport [LAX]); 20

21 NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree the Company will compensate each Flight Attendant 22 fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per event whenever s/he is required to clear Immigration and 23 Customs at TBIT due to a work assignment; such compensation will be automated (i.e. 24 no pay claim form required). 25

26 This Letter of Agreement will become effective on September 1, 2018, and any previous 27 agreements regarding excessive time to clear Immigration and Customs at TBIT are 28 retired upon the effective date.
