12 13 This LETTER OF AGREEMENT is made between ALASKA AIRLINES, INC. ("Company") 14 and the ASSOCIATION OF FLIGHT ATTENDANTS-CWA, AFL-CIO ("Association"). 15 16 WHEREAS, recent direction from Alaska Airlines Inflight Compliance, based on regulatory 17 guidance, has limited release of the Regualification Training home study computerbased training (CBT) to the first day of the month in which a Flight Attendant is 18 19 scheduled to attend training; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Section 30.B.3 [Training: Recurrent Training] of the Joint Collective

WHEREAS, Section 30.B.3 [Training: Recurrent Training] of the Joint Collective
 Bargaining Agreement requires that the Company offer a full Level I/Level II
 Requalification Training class within the first five (5) working days of every month; and

WHEREAS, the Company and the Association (collectively "the parties") recognize that
the limited timeframe during which a Flight Attendant has to complete the home study
CBT prior to attending Requalification Training places a greater burden on the Flight
Attendant; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to mitigate the burden by extending the amount of time that
a Flight Attendant has in which to complete the home study CBT prior to attending
Requalification Training;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree to extend the time period during which a Flight
 Attendant has to complete the Requalification Training home study CBT by temporarily
 administering Section 30.B.3 as follows:

- 423.Recurrent Training during or upon return from leave of absence the43Company will offer a full Level I/Level II Requalification Training class44within the first five (5) working days no sooner than the seventh (7th)45working day of every month. Flight Attendants who wish to attend46Recurrent or Level I/Level II Requalification Training, may attend one of
